[PROPOSED] FINDINGS AND ORDER**

In the matter of the civil penalty assessment against Darlene Hadley

On June 2, 2026, the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) reviewed the assessed civil penalty of **\$780** for Darlene Hadley's delinquent 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD) Statement. To date, Ms. Hadley has not filed a 2026 Annual POFD Statement. To facilitate collection proceedings by the Department of Law, the Commission issues the following Findings and Order.

Findings of Fact

1. Ms. Hadley serves on the Northwest Arctic Borough Planning Commission, and as a public official, is subject to AS 39.50 Public Official Financial Disclosure Law.
2. Ms. Hadley's 2026 Annual POFD Statement was due on March 16, 2026, and has not yet been filed.
3. On March 27, 2026, staff issued a Notice of Delinquency to Ms. Hadley's address of record informing her that, as of the date of the notice, her statement was 11 days late. The notice also informed Ms. Hadley that a daily civil penalty would continue to accrue until the statement was filed and that she had the right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and tracking for the certified mail indicates it has been preparing for delivery from the Buckland post office since March 30, 2026.¹ The first class mail has not been returned to APOC.
4. On April 7, 2026, staff issued a Second Notice of Delinquency to Ms. Hadley's address of record for her missing 2026 Annual Statement. The notice provided the amount of the penalty to date and again informed her of her right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and tracking for the certified mail indicates it has been in transit since April 11, 2026. The first class mail has not been returned to APOC.

As of the date of this letter, your Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement is **11 days** late and the accrued maximum penalty that may be assessed is **\$110**. This penalty continues to accrue by law at a rate of \$10 per day until your Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement is filed.

To stop the accrual of penalties, you must file your Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement. After your statement is filed, you will be notified of the assessed penalty amount. You have a right to appeal the assessment of a penalty. On March 27, 2026, staff sent you a notice of delinquency notifying you that the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) had not received your 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD) Statement, due on March 16, 2026. To date, your statement has not been filed.

Failure to timely file a statement results in the assessment of civil penalties. As of the date of this letter, your POFD statement is **22 days** late and the accrued maximum penalty that could be assessed is **\$220**. This penalty continues to accrue at a rate of \$10/day until your POFD statement is filed.

Further, failure or refusal to file a POFD statement is punishable as a misdemeanor under AS 39.50.060. Failure to file your statement within 30 days after the due date may result in further formal action including requesting the attorney general to initiate misdemeanor proceedings and taking other action as appropriate.²

To stop the accrual of penalties and to avoid further formal action, you must file your POFD statement. After your statement is filed, you will be notified of the assessed penalty amount. **You have a right to appeal the assessment of this penalty. Delinquent 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD)

Dear Ms. Hadley:

On March 27, 2026, the Alaska Public Offices Commission Staff notified you that your Annual POFD Statement, due March 16, 2026, was delinquent. This notice informed you of the accruing penalty and asked you to submit your POFD statement.¹ On April 7, 2026, APOC Staff again notified you of your delinquent statement, the accruing penalty, and other potential consequences that could result if you fail to file.² **As of the date of this letter, you have not filed your Annual POFD Statement – the statement is 45 days late and the accrued penalty is \$450. This penalty continues to accrue until your Annual POFD Statement is filed or the matter is referred to the Attorney General’s Office for further action.**

APOC Staff will now refer this matter to the Commission for a final order of referral to the Attorney General’s Office regarding your failure to file. The Commission will consider requesting the Attorney General to initiate misdemeanor and collection proceedings or other actions appropriate to enforce AS 39.50.³ This matter will be considered at the Commission’s June 2025 meeting. You will be notified in advance of that meeting should you wish to participate. To avoid formal Commission action regarding referral for failure to file, you must file your Annual POFD.

On June 2, 2026, the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) reviewed the assessed civil penalty of **\$780** for John Nashoanak's delinquent 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD) Statement. To date, Mr. Nashoanak has not filed a 2026 Annual POFD Statement. To facilitate collection proceedings by the Department of Law, the Commission issues the following Findings and Order.

Findings of Fact

1. Mr. Nashoanak serves on the Stebbins City Council, and as a public official, is subject to AS 39.50 – Public Official Financial Disclosure Law.
2. Mr. Nashoanak's 2026 Annual POFD Statement was due on March 16, 2026, and has not yet been filed.
3. On March 27, 2026, staff issued a Notice of Delinquency to Mr. Nashoanak's address of record informing him that, as of the date of the notice, his statement was 11 days late. The notice also informed Mr. Nashoanak that a daily civil penalty would continue to accrue until the statement was filed and that he had the right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful but tracking for the certified mail is not available.¹ Neither the certified mail nor the first class mail have been returned to APOC.
4. On April 7, 2026, staff issued a Second Notice of Delinquency to Mr. Nashoanak's address of record for his missing 2026 Annual Statement. The notice provided the amount of the penalty to date and again informed him of his right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and the certified mail was delivered on April 22, 2026.

5. On April 30, 2026, staff issued a Notice of Referral to Mr. Nashoanak’s address of record for his missing 2026 Annual POFD Statement. The notice provided the amount of the maximum accrued penalty, to date, and informed him that the matter would be considered by the Commission at its June 2026 meeting. The notice was sent by email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and the certified mail indicates it is in transit to the next facility with no update since May 4, 2026. The first class mail has not been returned to APOC.
6. To date, Mr. Nashoanak has not filed a 2026 Annual POFD Statement.

Conclusions of Law

Due to Mr. Nashoanak’s failure to file a 2026 Annual Statement, the Commission upholds the penalty assessment under the provisions of AS 39.50.135 and 2 AAC 50.855.

Commission staff has exhausted efforts to collect the delinquent statement and the penalty due and owing to the State of Alaska under 2 AAC 50.895 and approves referral of this case to the Office of the Attorney General to begin the formal collection process.

Decision and Order of the Commission

In accordance with the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission orders John Nashoanak to pay a civil penalty of **\$780** for failing to timely file a 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement and refers this matter for collection to the Office of the Attorney General.

BY ORDER OF THE COMMISSION ON JUNE 2, 2026

NOTICE TO RESPONDENT

You must pay the penalty of \$780 to the State of Alaska within thirty days from the date this order is distributed to you. To obtain judicial review of this order consistent with AS 44.62.560-570, you must file an appeal with the Superior Court within thirty days from the date this order is distributed to you.

In the matter of the civil penalty assessment against Elsie Sampson

On June 2, 2026, the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) reviewed the assessed civil penalty of **\$780** for Elsie Sampson's delinquent 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD) Statement. To date, Ms. Sampson has not filed a 2026 Annual POFD Statement. To facilitate collection proceedings by the Department of Law, the Commission issues the following Findings and Order.

Findings of Fact

1. Ms. Sampson serves on the Northwest Arctic Borough's Planning Commission, and as a public official, is subject to AS 39.50 – Public Official Financial Disclosure Law.
2. Ms. Sampson's 2026 Annual POFD Statement was due on March 16, 2026, and has not yet been filed.
3. On March 27, 2026, staff issued a Notice of Delinquency to Ms. Sampson's address of record informing her that, as of the date of the notice, her statement was 11 days late. The notice also informed Ms. Sampson that a daily civil penalty would continue to accrue until the statement was filed and that she had the right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and the certified mail was delivered on April 10, 2026.
4. On April 7, 2026, staff issued a Second Notice of Delinquency to Ms. Sampson's address of record for her missing 2026 Annual Statement. The notice provided the amount of the penalty to date and again informed her of her right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and the certified mail was delivered on April 20, 2026.
5. On April 30, 2026, staff issued a Notice of Referral to Ms. Sampson's address of record for her missing 2026 Annual POFD Statement. The notice provided the amount of the accrued maximum penalty, to date, and informed her that the matter would be considered by the Commission at its June 2026 meeting. The notice was sent by email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful. The certified mail indicates it is in transit to the next facility with no update since May 4, 2026.¹ The first class mail has not been returned to APOC.

6. To date, Ms. Sampson has not filed a 2026 Annual POFD Statement.

Conclusions of Law

Due to Ms. Sampson’s failure to file a 2026 Annual Statement, the Commission upholds the penalty assessment under the provisions of AS 39.50.135 and 2 AAC 50.855.

Commission staff has exhausted efforts to collect the delinquent statement and the penalty due and owing to the State of Alaska under 2 AAC 50.895 and approves referral of this case to the Office of the Attorney General to begin the formal collection process.

Decision and Order of the Commission

In accordance with the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission orders Elsie Sampson to pay a civil penalty of **\$780** for failing to timely file a 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement and refers this matter for collection to the Office of the Attorney General.

BY ORDER OF THE COMMISSION ON JUNE 2, 2026

NOTICE TO RESPONDENT

You must pay the penalty of \$780 to the State of Alaska within thirty days from the date this order is distributed to you. To obtain judicial review of this order consistent with AS 44.62.560-570, you must file an appeal with the Superior Court within thirty days from the date this order is distributed to you.

In the matter of the civil penalty assessment against Bruce Waskey

On June 2, 2026, the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) reviewed the assessed civil penalty of **\$780** for Bruce Waskey's delinquent 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD) Statement. To date, Mr. Waskey has not filed a 2026 Annual POFD Statement. To facilitate collection proceedings by the Department of Law, the Commission issues the following Findings and Order.

Findings of Fact

1. Mr. Waskey serves on Lower Kalskag's City Council, and as a public official, is subject to AS 39.50 – Public Official Financial Disclosure Law.
2. Mr. Waskey's 2026 Annual POFD Statement was due on March 16, 2026, and has not yet been filed.
3. On March 27, 2026, staff issued a Notice of Delinquency to Mr. Waskey's address of record informing him that, as of the date of the notice, his statement was 11 days late. The notice also informed Mr. Waskey that a daily civil penalty would continue to accrue until the statement was filed and that he had the right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and the certified was delivered on April 6, 2026.
4. On April 7, 2026, staff issued a Second Notice of Delinquency to Mr. Waskey's address of record for his missing 2026 Annual Statement. The notice provided the amount of the penalty to date and again informed him of his right to appeal the assessment of the penalty. The notice was sent via email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and the certified mail was delivered on April 17, 2026.
5. On April 30, 2026, staff issued a Notice of Referral to Mr. Waskey's address of record for his missing 2026 Annual POFD Statement. The notice provided the amount of the accrued maximum penalty, to date, and informed him that the matter would be considered by the Commission at its June 2026 meeting. The notice was sent by email, first class mail, and certified mail. Email delivery was successful and the certified mail was delivered on May 6, 2026.
6. To date, Mr. Waskey has not filed a 2026 Annual POFD Statement.

Conclusions of Law

Due to Mr. Waskey’s failure to file a 2026 Annual Statement, the Commission upholds the penalty assessment under the provisions of AS 39.50.135 and 2 AAC 50.855.

Commission staff has exhausted efforts to collect the delinquent statement and the penalty due and owing to the State of Alaska under 2 AAC 50.895 and approves referral of this case to the Office of the Attorney General to begin the formal collection process.

Decision and Order of the Commission

In accordance with the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission orders Bruce Waskey to pay a civil penalty of **\$780** for failing to timely file a 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement and refers this matter for collection to the Office of the Attorney General.

Dear Mr. Williams:

According to our records, you have not filed your Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement that was due on March 16, 2026. Failure to timely file a statement results in the assessment of civil penalties for failure to comply with the provisions of the Public Official Financial Disclosure Law under Alaska Statute 39.50.

As of the date of this letter, your Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement is **11 days** late and the accrued maximum penalty that may be assessed is **\$110**. This penalty continues to accrue by law at a rate of \$10 per day until your Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement is filed.

To stop the accrual of penalties, you must file your Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement. After your statement is filed, you will be notified of the assessed penalty amount. You have a right to appeal the assessment of a penalty. To do so, **you must submit your delinquent report and the enclosed appeal affidavit to the Commission within 30 days.** APOC staff will review your affidavit and prepare a recommendation for the Commission. You will receive a copy of that recommendation and notice of when the Commission will meet to consider the matter. You will have the opportunity to participate in the meeting either in-person or telephonically.

Dear Mr. Williams:

On March 27, 2026, staff sent you a notice of delinquency notifying you that the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) had not received your 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD) Statement, due on March 16, 2026. To date, your statement has not been filed.

Failure to timely file a statement results in the assessment of civil penalties. As of the date of this letter, your POFD statement is **22 days** late and the accrued maximum penalty that could be assessed is **\$220**. This penalty continues to accrue at a rate of \$10/day until your POFD statement is filed.

Further, failure or refusal to file a POFD statement is punishable as a misdemeanor under AS 39.50.060. Failure to file your statement within 30 days after the due date may result in further formal action including requesting the attorney general to initiate misdemeanor proceedings and taking other action as appropriate.²

To stop the accrual of penalties and to avoid further formal action, you must file your POFD statement. After your statement is filed, you will be notified of the assessed penalty amount. **You have a right to appeal the assessment of this penalty. If you wish to contest the assessment of this penalty, you must submit your delinquent report and the enclosed appeal affidavit to the Commission within 30 days of the date of this letter.** APOC staff will review your affidavit and prepare a recommendation for the Commission. You will receive a copy of that recommendation and notice of when the Commission will meet to

Delinquent 2026 Annual Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD)

Dear Mr. Williams:

On March 27, 2026, the Alaska Public Offices Commission Staff notified you that your Annual POFD Statement, due March 16, 2026, was delinquent. This notice informed you of the accruing penalty and asked you to submit your POFD statement.¹ On April 7, 2026, APOC Staff again notified you of your delinquent statement, the accruing penalty, and other potential consequences that could result if you fail to file.² **As of the date of this letter, you have not filed your Annual POFD Statement – the statement is 45 days late and the accrued penalty is \$450. This penalty continues to accrue until your Annual POFD Statement is filed or the matter is referred to the Attorney General’s Office for further action.**

APOC Staff will now refer this matter to the Commission for a final order of referral to the Attorney General’s Office regarding your failure to file. The Commission will consider requesting the Attorney General to initiate misdemeanor and collection proceedings or other actions appropriate to enforce AS 39.50.³ This matter will be considered at the Commission’s June 2025 meeting. You will be notified in advance of that meeting should you wish to participate. To avoid formal Commission action regarding referral for failure to file, you must file your Annual POFD.
